- ✍ Organization or Individual name, address and phone number
- ✍ Contact name and title (if applicable)
- ✍ Charitable registration number (if applicable)
- ✍ Brief history of your organization
- ✍ Brief project outline
- ✍ Amount of contribution sought
- ✍ How the donation will be used
- ✍ Who will benefit from your project or program
- ✍ Most recent financial statements (if applicable)
- ✍ Has your organization received funding from Kiwanis in the past?
- ✍ Recognition opportunities

Please keep submissions to a maximum of 2 pages.

The fiscal year runs from October – September. The Donations Committee meets four times per year. **2009-2010 submission deadlines, for fully documented applications, are Nov. 30/09, Feb. 28/10, May 30/10, Aug. 30/10**

Final decisions will be made by the Kiwanis Club of Brantford's Board of Directors. The Kiwanis Club of Brantford will advise you of the status of your request but explanations behind funding decisions will not be provided.
